Last month, the lodge was presented with a report from the Finance Committee and everything appears to be on track according to the estimates laid out in the budget for 2009.

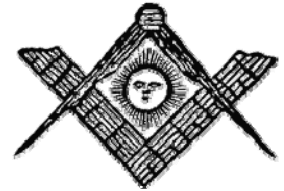

supported our girls at the home, and hosted a backyard barbeque for them at his own house when they came down here to go shopping.

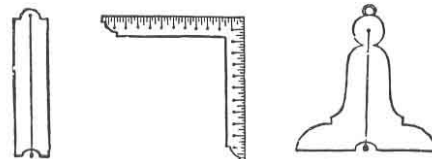

The York Rite

For the brethren seeking to discover the Master's Word that was lost, for the brethren who wish to pursue further light in Masonry, and for any and all Christian Masons, now is the time to consider joining the York Rite.

The York Rite consists of three main bodies- the Royal Arch Chapter, the Council of Royal and Select Masters, and the Commandery of Knights Templar.



The Royal Arch degrees continue and complete the Hiram Legend, culminating in the exaltation of the Holy Royal Arch. In these degrees, Masons also see the Temple completed, and discover the source of many of the phrases and traditions we observe in our Blue Lodges.



The Council of Royal and Select Masters, also called the Cryptic Council, adds further to the story of Hiram Abiff and further explains some of the events portrayed in the York Rite and Blue Lodge degrees.

The Commandery of Knights Templar consists of the chivalric orders-

the Illustrious Knight of the Red Cross, the Knight of Malta, and the Order of the Temple. These are based upon the legends of the Crusader Knights from the 12th and 13th centuries. These include some of the most impressive ceremonies in all Freemasonry.
